

LADDER PLAY

1. Ladder play consists of matches for 4 or 5 players at a similar skill level.
2. Each player plays with every other player in the match and final scores are posted with the coordinator.
3. Players sign up weekly, matches are created, and a ladder coordinator is assigned.
4. Matches are 3 games to 15 or 4 games to 11 with players changing partners after each game.
5. The scores for each player are recorded and posted by the Ladder Coordinator.
6. Depending on how well a player plays any given week, they move up or down the ladder.
7. Usually there are two ladders. One for beginning ladder players (2.5-3.0) and one for more experienced players (3.0 and above)
