LADDER PLAY

- 1. Ladder play consists of matches for 4 or 5 players at a similar skill level.
- 2. Each player plays with every other player in the match and final sores are posted with the coordinator.
- 3. Players sign up weekly, matches are created, and a ladder coordinator is assigned.
- 4. Matches are 3 games to 15 or 4 games to 11 with players changing partners after each game.
- 5. The scores for each player are recorded and posted by the Ladder Coordinator.
- 6. Depending on how well a player plays any given week, they move up or down the ladder.
- 7. Usually there are two ladders. One for beginning ladder players (2.5-3.0) and one for more experienced players (3.0 and above)
